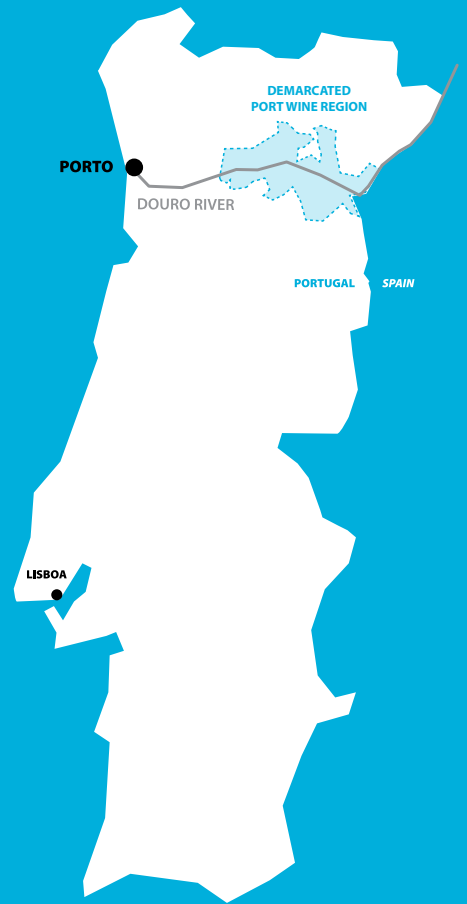

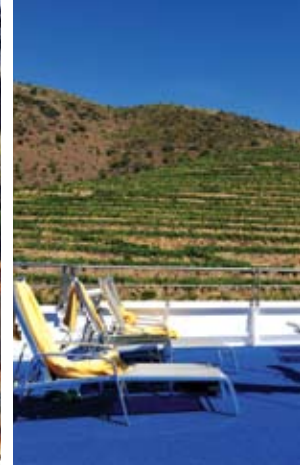

# DOURO VALLEY LAND TOURS

## PORTO

First a Celtic-Iberian settlement, Porto became prosperous Roman village thanks to its busy harbour. This medieval town of fishermen, sailors and merchants, ship building activity contributed to the success of the Portuguese Discoveries during the 15th and 16th centuries. In the 18th century Porto gives its name to the one of the finest wines in the world – the Port Wine.

You will have the opportunity to get to know this city, the capital of the North of Portugal and to drive through its narrow streets with 16th century arcaded buildings and Baroque churches and chapels. We will cross its 19th century iron bridge, built by the school of Gustav Eiffel. The city tour takes us along the coastal road of the Atlantic to the mouth of the Douro river at "Foz". There, this posh neighbourhood of Porto shows its fashionable Villas and Manor Houses.

And of course don't miss the a visit to one of the Port Wine Lodges, located in Vila Nova de Gaia, where you will have the opportunity to see the old casks of Port and sample this delicious Portuguese wine.



## THE PALACE AND THE GARDENS OF MATEUS

At the Palace of Mateus you discover why Mateus Rose Wine is connected to this beautiful XVIII Century Villa. Still owned by the Count of Vila Real, the palace has been transformed into a Cultural Foundation called "Casa de Mateus", the House of Mateus. Its main aims: the preservation of the house, the study of its archive and the promotion of cultural, scientific and educational activities.

In the interior of the Palace, you will visit the library, a small museum where you will see liturgical vestments, a collection of silver reliquaries from the 18th century, a 17th century woodcraft altar, ivory images of Our Lady of Conception (17th century) and a "Descent from the Cross" (18th century), amongst several other images and Religious curiosities. You will also have a chance to see Portuguese, French and English furniture from the 17th and 18th centuries as well as paintings from the same period. Don't forget to look at the ceilings' remarkable chestnut woodcraft.

Finally, enjoy your time in the beautiful sculpted gardens, among Portugal's most beautiful.





## SALAMANCA

Situated in the centre of the “Castilla e León” region, Salamanca is a very rich city full of traditions. The city was founded by Celtic-Iberian tribes on the banks of the Tormes river. Later, it was occupied by the Romans and the Arabs and finally reconquered by the Christians in the 12th century. During the 13th century the oldest university of the Iberian Peninsula was created there.

The city was visited several times during the centuries by kings, princes, bishops and artists who all contributed to its enrichment. That is why we say that Salamanca is a “living museum”.

In addition to the historic monuments are Salamanca’s 40.000 students from all over the world and its 160.000 permanent inhabitants, all who help make the city very busy and transform it into a very happy, multicoloured, fascinating and cosmopolitan city.

The walking city tour will take you to visit the New Cathedral, University, House of Shells and the beautiful “Plaza Mayor” where, in the past, one could see bullfights. In 2002 Salamanca was recognized as a Global Capital of Culture and the city has been a UNESCO World Heritage site since 1988.

## FIGUEIRA CASTELO RODRIGO

Imagine three places located next to each other that work like a time machine taking you centuries back to days Moors and Christians were fighting and before the foundation of the Portuguese territory.

We will visit the newly restored ruins of Castelo Rodrigo. Castelo Rodrigo is an enchanting place with medieval streets and walls protecting the granite houses that are still home to locals who are proud to live in one of Portugal’s few historic parishes. From the ruins of the castle have a look at the beautiful white village called Figueira de Castelo Rodrigo. It lies at the bottom of the Marofa Mountain. It is a very hospitable place that has been isolated for many years. Walk along its streets and enjoy the beauty of its ex libris, the stork nest on the Igreja Matriz tower, and find out how a stork named “Joana” became the village pet.



## LAMEGO & THE SANCTUARY OF OUR LADY OF REMEDIES

Small but picturesque, warm and very charming, Lamego houses one of the most important places of pilgrimage in the country, the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies. Built in the second half of the 18th century, it is a good example of Portuguese baroque. Embracing the whole town from the top of the hill is its impressive staircase with almost 700 steps. The staircase is beautifully decorated with enormous panels of blue and white tiles.

Besides the shrine you will have free time to visit the Gothic Cathedral, the Town’s Museum, or to just wonder around the town’s narrow and winding streets. The town is also famous for its gastronomy. Among its favourite dishes are smoked ham, “Bola de Lamego” (bread filled in with smoked ham), roasted kid, regional cakes and very well-known sparkling wine called “Raposeira”.

## EXECUTIVE HELICOPTER

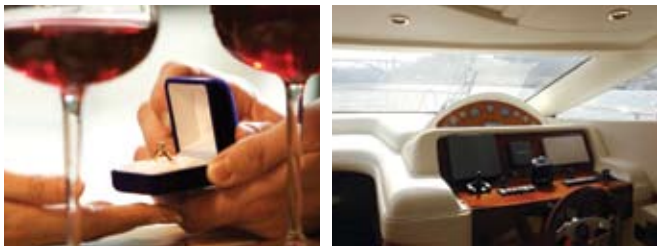

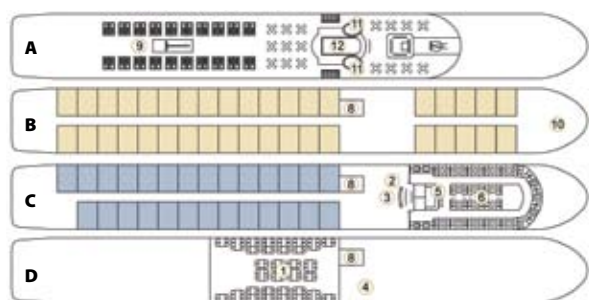

# GENERAL CONDITIONS

## Cancelled, delayed or altered sailing itineraries

DouroAzul, S. A. retains the right to cancel, delay or alter the itinerary of any voyage for any reason including, but not limited to: charter of vessel, insufficient bookings, bad weather conditions, mechanical difficulties, medical emergency, local strike or work stoppage, local holidays, and other reasons, without penalty to DouroAzul, S. A.

## Pricing

Prices included in the brochure are correct at the time of printing. Prices are subject to change based upon addition of unforeseen government charges, fuel taxes or surcharges, or the change of any outside costs not under the control of DouroAzul, S. A. All categories of all ships may not be available at the prices listed on all sailings if previously purchased. Prices include VAT. Children under two years age travel for free. Children from 3 to 11 years of age at the time of embarkation travel at 50% discount.

## Contracted services

The ship's masseuse, local guides, meals ashore, some transportation providers and other services as required are contracted from third-party companies and are not direct employees of DouroAzul, S. A. Accordingly, in the provision of these services DouroAzul, S. A. acts only as the sales agent and is not responsible for claims against these entities resulting from actions on their behalf.

## Complaints and Claims

Complaints and claims will only be considered if reported by the claimant to DouroAzul, S. A. in writing within 5 days of the end of service. All disputes will be settled before the Court of the Borough of Porto.

## Reservations

Reservations will only be considered confirmed when 50% of the full payment has been received. Reservation bookings must be made direct to DouroAzul, S. A. or through one of its recognized distribution companies, travel agents, wholesale agents or tour operators.

Changes in reservations after the initial booking will be charged up to €50 per change, including name, address, voyage and sail date, category, and other changes.

DouroAzul, S. A. retains the right to alter the on board cabin category, either up or downgrade, when necessary. In the event of a downgrade in category full compensation will be given of the difference between the category booked and final cabin occupied. Payments may be paid by credit card, bank transfer, bank cheque, or in cash money. Once reserved, the following cancellation charges apply in the event the reservation is cancelled:

90 days or more prior to departure date: 25% of total reservation;

from 89 to 60 days prior to departure date: 50% of total reservation;

from 59 to 30 days prior to departure date: 75% of total reservation;

from 29 to 1 day prior to departure date: 100% of total reservation.

No show on day of departure: 100% of total reservation

All cancellation charges are subject to additional charges incurred by DouroAzul, S. A. for non-refundable transportation, hotel, food & beverage, contracted services or other charges related to the passenger's reservation. These additional costs will be charged to the passenger in addition to the standard cancellation charges.

## Casino Gambling

DouroAzul, S. A. does not have casinos on board its ships. DouroAzul, S. A. does operate organized land programs in and near legal casinos. It is up to passengers to comply with local gaming laws and entrance requirements. It is the responsibility of parents and responsible adults to ensure minors' compliance with local gaming restrictions. DouroAzul, S. A. is not responsible for issues or losses arising from a passenger's gaming or failure to comply with local gaming laws.

## Children

All children under the age of 18 years of age on the day of embarkation must be accompanied by a responsible parent or adult guardian over 18 years of age. DouroAzul, S. A. does not guarantee availability of infant crib or bedding; booster seats; bus safety seats; or other facilities. DouroAzul, S. A. does not provide baby sitting and does not operate a children's activity program. Children under 6 years of age will not be permitted on bus tours unless with a certified safe child car seat (not provided by DouroAzul, S. A.).

## On board Pool/Jacuzzi

The ship's master and hotel manager reserve the right to establish the operating hours of the ship's pool and Jacuzzi as they see fit according to safety, weather, ship's location, and other reasons. The following guidelines apply to use of the ship's pool and Jacuzzi: use is prohibited to passengers displaying the effect of alcohol consumption; permitted only to passengers wearing proper swim wear; ship's management retains the right to limit or prohibit use by any passenger they deem a threat to the ship, its passengers or their self. The following age restrictions apply to the use of ship's pool and Jacuzzi: passengers under 15 years must be monitored by a responsible parent or adult guardian; passengers less than 10 years may not use the ship's Jacuzzi unless accompanied in the Jacuzzi by a parent or adult guardian; passengers under 6 years old may not use the ship's Jacuzzi.

## Clothing

On board attire ranges from resort casual (shorts, tee and polo shirts, beach wear, etc.) to country club casual (slacks, dresses/pant suits, blazer with tie optional, long-sleeve button shirts, skirts, etc.). There is no formal night wear required. Gentlemen may opt to wear a business suit and ladies may opt to wear a cocktail dress to the Captain's welcome or farewell reception or any of the evening shore side events. For the comfort and respect of all guests Short pants are not permitted in the dining room for dinner and bathing suits are not permitted in the dining room at any time. Wet bathing suits are not permitted in any inside public areas except when a passenger is transiting to/from their cabin and the pool area. Nude and topless sunbathing is not permitted anywhere on board ship and not acceptable on Portuguese public beaches.

## Currency

The on board currency is Euros. Passengers may pay their shipboard accounts with credit cards from their country and the amount will be automatically converted to their local country's currency by the credit card bank. Automatic money dispensing machines are available in many areas on shore and these machines will accept all bank cards belonging to the normal international bank networks (Cirrus, Star, etc.) and dispense Euro notes.

## Customs & Immigrations

Passengers are responsible to possess the required immigration documentation to enter Portugal and to visit Spain before arriving from their home country. Failure to enter Portugal due to incorrect immigration documentation may result in cancelling of the cruise as a No Show and no refund will be offered. Passengers are individually responsible for complying with international customs regulations when departing Portugal and entering their home countries. DouroAzul, S. A. is not responsible for any Customs charges resulting from products received or purchased, including wine and alcoholic beverages, during the cruise vacation.

## Government Taxes and Fees

The cruise fare includes all applicable government travel taxes and fees for the cruise portion only. Airport taxes, exit taxes, immigration taxes and other travel taxes are the responsibility of the individual traveller and differ according to an individual's travel route and country of origin and destination. Any uncertainty prior to travel should be addressed with your travel agent/professional.

## Valuables

Safes are not provided on board the Invicta ship and are provided on board the Douro Cruiser. Passengers are responsible for the safety and protection of their valuables.

## Health and Medical matters

DouroAzul, S. A. ships do not maintain on board medical assistance or facilities. Medical emergencies are attended to at local medical facilities. Although Portugal and Spain are modern countries with medical facilities of the quality normally found in a modern European country, DouroAzul, S. A. can not guarantee the quality of medical treatment at shore side facilities. DouroAzul, S. A. does not provide crew members to push passengers in wheelchairs and guests travelling in a wheelchair are required to travel with a companion capable of assisting with their wheel chair and mobility. The Douro Cruiser has an elevator and chair lift that allow passengers with limited mobility access to all passenger decks. Other DouroAzul ships have stairways and access to various ship areas may be challenging or not possible to passengers with limited mobility. Cabins do not have refrigerators and DouroAzul, S. A. does not provide facilities to refrigerate medicines. Tours ashore provide varying physical challenges and these challenges can be described in detail on board ship by the ship's tour escorts; failure of a passenger to fully enjoy a land tour because of their inability to participate in all elements of the tour will not be reason for a refund of any portion of the tour.

## Wireless Internet Connection

Wireless internet connection is available on the Douro Cruiser and Invicta. Connection bandwidth and area of ship coverage is limited but sufficient for normal internet messaging. An individual's use may be limited to allow more passengers opportunity to get on line. Ship's receptionists will assist passengers in receiving maximum available use of the ship's Wi-Fi capabilities. There is an additional, on board charge for Wi-Fi use.

## Laundry Services (only available at Douro Cruiser)

Ships do not have self-service laundry machines. Personal laundry services incur additional charges. The scope of services varies by ship and can be fully explained on board.

## Mail

Outbound national and international mail postage is available on board at nominal charges. See the receptionists for assistance.

## Scope of Responsibility

DouroAzul, S. A. operates river and coastal cruises and is responsible for all operations, except those contracted from third-party service providers as described above, from the time of passenger embarkation to debark. DouroAzul, S. A. is responsible for airport/ship/airport transfers only when purchased by from DouroAzul, S. A. by passengers or their tour company. DouroAzul, S. A. is not responsible for performance of airlines, hotels, pre and post cruise overland tour companies, shore side guides, tour package providers, or any other elements of a passenger's vacation experience outside of the cruise portion of their vacation.

## Pets

DouroAzul, S. A. ships do not permit pets. Seeing-eye and other personal assistance animals will be accommodated and require specific coordination is required at the time of booking.

## Shore Excursions and Land Tours

Each DouroAzul, S. A. ship carries a professional tour escort who is available to assist passengers with the selection and attendance of Shore Excursions. Shore excursions are provided for purchase on board. Ample space is available for all passengers on all tours and all requests will be fulfilled if made prior to the day of the tour's departures. Land tour operations may be adjusted based upon local road, traffic, holidays, and weather conditions. When meals are included on a tour, meals include wine and water and all tips are included in the price of the tour. Tour briefings will be given nightly on board ship. Tours cancelled or adjusted by DouroAzul, S. A. will be refunded for that portion of the tour not attended or substituted. Tours cancelled by passengers within 48 hours of departure will not be refunded.

## Smoking Policy

Smoking is not allowed in any inside areas of the ships. Cigarettes are only allowed at the Sun deck. Pipes and cigars are not allowed anywhere in the ship including Sun deck. Any passenger found smoking inside the ships will be debarked and their cruise fare not refunded.

## Visitors

Visitors will only be permitted on board if previously arranged with the ship's reception desk, approved by the ship's master, and the visitor identified by recognized government identification upon arrival. Visitors dining on board will be charged the meal price stipulated on board and accommodated based upon space available.

## Insurance
